Updated Visitors During Covid-19 Pandemic

At Incey Winceys Day Nursery and Preschool we always value the safety of the children and the premises, for this reason we retain the right to refuse a visitor entry if we feel this is necessary.

We will not tolerate abusive behaviour towards any of our staff and we ask that visitors are respectful of the premises and our other policies, eg by not smoking near the building, not using mobile phones at all on the premises, not using profanities or abusive language.

In light of the recent Covid-19 health crisis, we have suspended all parents' fingerprint entry to the building to restrict visitors. This will continue until we are advised otherwise.

We have also reduced show round visitors who are looking for a nursery place to Friday afternoons, when the numbers of children are particularly low.

Visitors will need to provide their full name, contact number and address to be able to visit, to allow us to adhere to the NHS track and trace system. Details will be held for 21 days and in the event of a positive test of someone at the nursery they may be contacted. It is imperative the details provided are accurate and current.

Visitors will have their temperature taken by a member of staff using a contactless thermal imaging thermometer.

Visitors that have any symptoms of the coronavirus such as cough, fever or loss of taste and smell – or just feel generally unwell – please stay at home and follow the NHS guidelines. **We retain the right to refuse entry to anyone we deem as unwell.**

Visitors must always wear a mask when inside the premises and are advised that there is a hand sanitizer unit behind the front door, and one outside each childcare room. Visitors must always adhere to social distancing regulations and maintain 1m+ from others.
